Go to the App store on your IOS device and search for Panopto. Then install and configure it as follows:



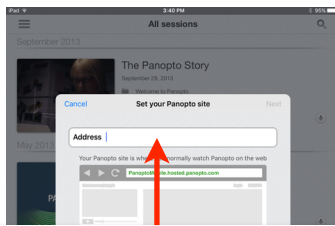
Tap on download.
